

# LOCAL LAW 3 OF 2016

Passed March 9, 2016

Local Law 3 of 2016 was enacted to give the Town Board flexibility in granting licenses for selling goods and services in the Town. The existing law allowed the Board to set the term of the license but did not allow it to create different types of licenses or to set eligibility criteria.

<p><b>§ 154-10 Term of license.</b> Licenses under this article may be granted or renewed for such periods as shall be established by separate resolution of the Town Board.</p>	<p><b>§ 154-10 Term and class of license.</b> <b>A.</b> Licenses under this article may be granted or renewed for such periods as shall be established by separate resolution of the Town Board. <b>B.</b> <u>The Town Board may, by separate resolution, create specific classes of license as it deems necessary. The power shall include, but not be limited to, the specification of eligibility criteria, delegation of discretion over the granting of such licenses, and the designation of specific locations and events at which such licenses shall be valid.</u></p>
